WHEREAS, this free, easy-to-use Together Rx Access Card is offered by the following pharmaceutical companies: Novartis, GlaxoSmithKline, Abbott Laboratories, AstraZeneca, Bristol-Myers Squibb Company, Johnson & Johnson, Pfizer, sanofi-aventis Group, Takeda, and TAP Pharmaceutical Products Inc., NOW, THEREFORE,
