insert:

Section 3. Subsection (2) of section 459.015, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

459.015 Grounds for disciplinary action; action by the
board and department.--

(2) The board may enter an order denying licensure or
imposing any of the penalties in s. 456.072(2) against any
applicant for licensure or licensee who is found guilty of
violating any provision of subsection (1) of this section or
who is found guilty of violating any provision of s.
456.072(1). A probable cause panel considering disciplinary
action against a physician assistant pursuant to s. 456.073
shall include a licensed physician assistant designated by the
Council on Physician Assistants. In determining what action is
appropriate, the board must first consider what sanctions are

1 necessary to protect the public or to compensate the patient.
 2 Only after those sanctions have been imposed may the
 3 disciplining authority consider and include in the order
 4 requirements designed to rehabilitate the physician. All
 5 costs associated with compliance with orders issued under this
 6 subsection are the obligation of the physician.
