Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between page 14, line 31 and page 15, line 1

insert: (1) Increased population densities in coastal high-hazard areas within historical downtowns shall be permitted where adequate hazard mitigation planning provides for safe evacuation and the downtown is part of a community redevelopment area with an adopted community redevelopment plan. An adequate hazard mitigation plan must include the participation of the county emergency management agency and requirements that development authorized within the redevelopment area provides mitigation proportional to its impact to offset the increased demand on evacuation clearance times and public shelter space.
