(3) PAYMENT AND DISPOSITION OF TAXES.--

(a) Payment for the tax on slot machines revenues imposed

by this section shall be paid to the division. The division shall deposit these sums with the Chief Financial Officer, to the credit of the Pari-mutuel Wagering Trust Fund. The slot machine licensee shall remit to the division payment for the tax on slot machine revenues. Such payments shall be remitted by 3 p.m. Wednesday of each week for taxes imposed and collected for the preceding week ending on Sunday. The slot machine licensee shall file a report under oath by the 5th day of each calendar month for all taxes remitted during the preceding calendar

17 showing all slot machine gaming activities for the preceding
18 calendar month and such other information as may be prescribed

20 (b) From moneys received under this section, up to \$500
21 per machine shall be transferred to the district school board of
22 the district in which the machine is located to be distributed
23 as provided in this paragraph.

24 1. The school district where the slot machine licensee is
25 located shall request such moneys as are available under this
26 subsection for reimbursement of the following additional
27 expenses:

- 28 a. Supplemental public education instruction expenses;
- 29 b. Classroom and school facilities construction expenses;
- 30 c. School safety expenses; or
- 31 d. Educational infrastructure expenses.

33 Eligible expenses under this paragraph must have been incurred
34 as a direct result of the slot machine licensee's operation of
35 slot machines in the school district during the immediately

37 2. The Department of Education shall distribute the moneys

39 the school district only after conducting an independent audit
