The division shall adopt rules requiring the 12 13 reporting of injuries incurred by greyhounds while racing in this state, including schooling races. Such reports must 14 15 include: 1. The greyhound's registered name and right and left 16 ear tattoo numbers. 17 2. The name, business address, and telephone number of 18 the greyhound owner, trainer, and kennel operator. 19 20 3. The color, weight, and sex of the greyhound. 4. The specific type of injury, the cause of the 21 22 injury, the estimated recovery time, and the location of the 23 injury on the greyhound. 24 5. If the injury occurred while the greyhound was 26 racing, the racetrack where the injury occurred; the distance, 27 grade, race, and post position when the injury occurred; and 28 29 the weather conditions, time, temperature, and track condition at the time of the injury. 30 7.
