The Committee on Regulated Industries (Geller) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 41, between lines 16 and 17,

insert:

Section 4. An annual fee of \$500 per slot machine is imposed upon each slot machine approved for use at any eligible facility as defined in s. 551.102, Florida Statutes, which is within 2 miles of any neighboring municipality. A "neighboring municipality" is defined as a municipality that does not have an eligible facility but has more than two facilities located within 2 miles of its municipal borders. Revenue from the fees imposed by this section must be used by the neighboring municipality to fund the adverse public health, safety, and welfare and public works and traffic impacts that will be caused by the implementation of Section 23, Article X of the State Constitution and that will occur as a direct result of slot machine operations. The annual fee must be remitted to the Division of Pari-mutuel Wagering to be

1 deposited into the Pari-mutuel Wagering Trust Fund and
 2 distributed by the division to any neighboring municipality.
 3 The fee must be remitted by February 1 of each year based on
 4 the number of slot machines approved by the division as of
