The Committee on Regulated Industries (Geller) recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment**

On page 42., between lines 27 and 28,

insert:

(3) The sums of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ in recurring and \$ \_\_\_\_\_ in nonrecurring funds are hereby appropriated from the Pari-mutuel Wagering Trust Fund in the Department of Business and Professional Regulation for transfer to the Office of the State Attorney, 17th Judicial Circuit, for the purpose of prosecution of offenses associated with gaming operations. Ten full-time equivalent positions are authorized and the sums of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ in recurring and \$ \_\_\_\_\_ in nonrecurring funds are hereby appropriated from the Grants and Donations Trust Fund in the Office of the State Attorney, 17th Judicial Circuit, for the purpose of prosecution of offenses associated with gaming operations.
