The sum of \$5 million is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to Workforce Florida, Inc., for the 2005-11 12 2006 fiscal year to provide temporary child care assistance to enable citizens of this state who became unemployed as a result 13 14 of Hurricane Wilma to return to work. A citizen of this state 15 who became unemployed as a result of Hurricane Wilma and whose 16 income does not exceed 200 percent of the federal poverty level 17 is eligible to receive an amount not to exceed \$200 per week for 18 up to 12 weeks for temporary child care assistance from the 19 funds appropriated in this section. Assistance provided under 20 this section shall be limited to an amount that, together with 21 all other child care benefits received by the applicant from any 22 government entity or private sector source other than a family member, does not exceed the limit established in this section. 23 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
