A bill to be entitled

An act relating to hurricane relief; providing an appropriation for no-interest loans to assist local governments and school districts affected by a natural disaster resulting in a declaration of a state of emergency; providing for administration and use of such loans; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) There is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Emergency Management, Preparedness, and Assistance Trust Fund for the 2005-2006 fiscal year a sum sufficient to be distributed to local governments and school districts affected by a natural disaster resulting in a declaration of a state of emergency for no-interest loans to be used for any of the following:

- (a) Paying personnel;
- (b) Debris removal;
- (c) Emergency food and shelter; or
- (d) Other relief that will be reimbursed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

(2) Such loans shall be administered pursuant to s. 252.373, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
