Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding s. 112.061, Florida Statutes, any state employee who, as a part of his or her job, is or was required to travel at any time during the period from July 1, 2005, through December 31, 2005, to perform work related to a state of emergency declared by the Governor pursuant to chapter 252, Florida Statutes, shall be entitled to a mileage allowance of 48.5 cents per mile. Any such employee already reimbursed on the basis of a lesser allowance for work performed during that period shall be reimbursed the remaining difference between that lesser amount and the amount authorized by this section.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law 21 and shall apply retroactively to July 1, 2005.
