Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 382 and 383,

insert:

Section 9. For purposes of ss. 810.08 and 810.09, Florida Statutes, a person may not lawfully remain on any property or in any structure that is held open to the public generally for commercial purposes and that sells agricultural products or is permitted under chapter 500, Florida Statutes, after the owner or its agent orders that person to leave the premises because the person is engaged in an activity deemed by the owner or its agent to be detrimental to the commercial purposes for which the premises is held open to the public.
