The Committee on Community Affairs (Bennett) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 39, between lines 13 and 14,

insert:

Section 8. In order to maintain the security of the ports of this state and to ensure the continuous flow of goods critical to the economic health and prosperity of this state, the ports of Jacksonville, Tampa, Port Everglades, Miami, Port Canaveral, Ft. Pierce, Palm Beach, Port Manatee, Port St. Joe, Panama City, St. Petersburg, Pensacola, Fernandina, and Key West may not transfer ownership or exclusive management control of real property or port operations to an entity controlled by a foreign government or foreign business entity without the express consent of the Legislature.

Section 9. If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid
