On page 50, between lines 22 and 23,

insert:

Section 11. For purposes of ss. 810.08 and 810.09,
Florida Statutes, a person may not lawfully remain on any
property or in any structure that is held open to the public
generally for commercial purposes after the owner or the
owner's agent orders that person to leave the premises because
the person is engaged in an activity that is deemed by the
owner or the owner's agent to be detrimental to the commercial
purposes for which the premises is held open to the public.
