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- (d) Reinvestment payments made under this subsection shall commence no later than 6 months after the grantee has received the final disbursement and shall continue until the maximum reinvestment has been paid.
- (e) All reinvestment payments made pursuant to this subsection shall be remitted to the Department of Elderly Affairs for deposit in the General Revenue Fund.
