A resolution recognizing St. Petersburg on
being selected one of the One Hundred Best
Communities in America for Young People.

WHEREAS, this year "America's Promise - The Alliance
for Youth" teamed up with Capital One Financial Corporation in
a first-ever national competition to identify the best
communities in America for young people, and

WHEREAS, the criteria by which communities were to be
judged included community support of children and youth,
resources provided to children and youth in the community, and
consequent outcomes for children and youth, and

WHEREAS, these criteria were based on the following
five promises to children - caring adults, safe places, a
healthy start, effective education, and opportunities to help
others, and

WHEREAS, St. Petersburg met all these criteria to
become designated one of the One Hundred Best Communities for
Young People in the nation, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida:

That the Senate recognizes and commends the
achievements of the City of St. Petersburg in providing a
