The Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability shall evaluate the continuing 18 education requirements related to identifying victims of child 19 20 abuse required for those individuals in the occupational 21 categories that are required to provide their names to child abuse hotline staff when reporting known or suspected child 22 abuse, neglect, or abandonment.
