16 106.0705, reports shall be filed not later than 5 p.m. of the

18 States Postal Service no later than midnight of the day
19 designated shall be deemed to have been filed in a timely
20 manner. Any report received by the filing officer within 5 days
21 after the designated due date that was delivered by the United
22 States Postal Service shall be deemed timely filed unless it has
23 a postmark that indicates that the report was mailed after the
24 designated due date. A certificate of mailing obtained from and
25 dated by the United States Postal Service at the time of
26 mailing, or a receipt from an established courier company, which
27 bears a date on or before the date on which the report is due,
28 shall be proof of mailing in a timely manner. Reports shall
29 contain information of all previously unreported contributions
30 received and expenditures made as of the preceding Friday,
31 except that the report filed on the Friday immediately preceding
32 the election shall contain information of all previously
33 unreported contributions received and expenditures made as of
34 the day preceding that designated due date. All such reports
35 shall be open to public inspection.
