The Broward County Property Appraiser shall, 11 within 90 business days after receipt of the findings of the 12 Florida Department of Revenue regarding the Broward County 13 assessment rolls, forward a copy of the findings to the Mayor of Broward County. The data furnished to the mayor shall be 14 15 identical to that furnished to the property appraiser, including all statistical and analytical measures computed for the real 16 17 property assessment roll as a whole and the personal property assessment roll as a whole and, independently for the real 18 property classes and subclasses studied, results of any audit or 19 20 review of procedures used by the county property appraiser. If Broward County is not being studied in the current year, the 21 findings must include any value-weighted mean levels of 22 23 assessment projected for that year pursuant to state law. 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
