An act relating to insurance agents; amending s. 626.171, F.S.; revising certain fingerprinting requirements; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 626.171, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 626.171 Application for license as an agent, customer representative, adjuster, service representative, managing general agent, or reinsurance intermediary.--
- (4) An application for a license as an agent, customer representative, adjuster, service representative, managing general agent, or reinsurance intermediary must be accompanied by a set of the individual applicant's fingerprints, or, if the applicant is not an individual, by a set of the fingerprints of the sole proprietor, majority owner, partners, officers, and directors, on a form adopted by rule of the department and accompanied by the fingerprint processing fee set forth in s. 624.501. Fingerprints shall be used to investigate the applicant's qualifications pursuant to s. 626.201. The Fingerprints may shall be taken at by a law enforcement agency or other department-approved entity and shall be available at all designated examination centers.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2007.
