2 An act relating to travel to terrorist states; amending s.
3 1011.81, F.S.; prohibiting the use of funds from the
4 Community College Program Fund, or funds made available to
5 community colleges from outside the fund, to implement,
6 organize, direct, coordinate, or administer activities
7 related to or involving travel to a terrorist state;
8 defining "terrorist state"; amending s. 1011.90, F.S.;
9 prohibiting the use of state or nonstate funds made
10 available to state universities to implement, organize,
11 direct, coordinate, or administer activities related to or
12 involving travel to a terrorist state; defining "terrorist
13 state"; amending s. 112.061, F.S.; providing that travel
14 expenses of public officers or employees for the purpose
15 of implementing, organizing, directing, coordinating, or
16 administering activities related to or involving travel to
17 a terrorist state shall not be allowed under any
18 circumstances; defining "terrorist state"; providing an
19 effective date.

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21 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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23 Section 1. Section 1011.81, Florida Statutes, is amended
24 to read:

25 1011.81 Community College Program Fund.--

26 (1) There is established a Community College Program Fund.
27 This fund shall comprise all appropriations made by the
28 Legislature for the support of the current operating program and

29 shall be apportioned and distributed to the community college
 30 districts of the state on the basis of procedures established by
 31 law and rules of the State Board of Education. The annual
 32 apportionment for each community college district shall be
 33 distributed monthly in payments as nearly equal as possible.

34 (2) None of the funds made available in the Community
 35 College Program Fund, or funds made available to community
 36 colleges outside the Community College Program Fund, may be used
 37 to implement, organize, direct, coordinate, or administer, or to
 38 support the implementation, organization, direction,
 39 coordination, or administration of, activities related to or
 40 involving travel to a terrorist state. For purposes of this
 41 section, "terrorist state" is defined as any state, country, or
 42 nation designated by the United States Department of State as a
 43 state sponsor of terrorism.

44 Section 2. Subsection (6) is added to section 1011.90,
 45 Florida Statutes, to read:

46 1011.90 State university funding.--

47 (6) None of the state or nonstate funds made available to
 48 state universities may be used to implement, organize, direct,
 49 coordinate, or administer, or to support the implementation,
 50 organization, direction, coordination, or administration of,
 51 activities related to or involving travel to a terrorist state.
 52 For purposes of this section, "terrorist state" is defined as
 53 any state, country, or nation designated by the United States
 54 Department of State as a state sponsor of terrorism.

55 Section 3. Paragraphs (e), (f), and (g) of subsection (3)
 56 of section 112.061, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as

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57 paragraphs (f), (g), and (h), respectively, and a new paragraph
58 (e) is added to that subsection to read:

59 112.061 Per diem and travel expenses of public officers,
60 employees, and authorized persons.--

61 (3) AUTHORITY TO INCUR TRAVEL EXPENSES.--

62 (e) Travel expenses of public officers or employees for
63 the purpose of implementing, organizing, directing,
64 coordinating, or administering, or supporting the
65 implementation, organization, direction, coordination, or
66 administration of, activities related to or involving travel to
67 a terrorist state shall not be allowed under any circumstances.
68 For purposes of this section, "terrorist state" is defined as
69 any state, country, or nation designated by the United States
70 Department of State as a state sponsor of terrorism.

71 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
