Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Osun's Village designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--
- (1) That portion of N.W. 7th Avenue between N.W. 54th

 Street and N.W. 60th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated
 as "Osun's Village."
- (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Osun's Village as described in subsection (1).
- Section 2. <u>African Caribbean Cultural Arts Corridor</u>

 <u>designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable</u>

 <u>markers.--</u>
- (1) That portion of N.W. 7th Avenue between N.W. 36th

 Street and N.W. 79th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated
 as "African Caribbean Cultural Arts Corridor."

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- (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating African Caribbean Cultural Arts

 Corridor as described in subsection (1).

 Section 3. Burl Marler Walkway designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--
- (1) The pedestrian overpass on John Sims Parkway in the City of Niceville in Okaloosa County is designated as "Burl Marler Walkway."
- (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Burl Marler Walkway as described in subsection (1).
- Section 4. <u>Dr. Phillip A. Payne Bridge designated;</u>
 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--
- (1) The Cervantes Street Bridge on U.S. Highway 90 over Bayou Texar in the City of Pensacola in Escambia County is designated as "Dr. Phillip A. Payne Bridge."
- (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Dr. Phillip A. Payne Bridge as described in subsection (1).
- Section 5. <u>Carlos C. Lopez-Aguiar Way designated;</u>

 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--
- (1) That portion of S.W. 1st Street between 8th Avenue and 12th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated as "Carlos C. Lopez-Aguiar Way."
- (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Carlos C. Lopez-Aguiar Way as described in subsection (1).

99	Section 8. Senator N. Ray Carroll Memorial Interchange
100	designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable

102	(1) The Florida Turnpike interchange being constructed at
103	Milepost 240 and Kissimmee Park Road in Osceola County is
104	designated as "Senator N. Ray Carroll Memorial Interchange."
105	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
106	suitable markers designating Senator N. Ray Carroll Memorial

Interchange as described in subsection (1).

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108	Section 9. Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard designated;
109	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers; repeal
110	of prior designation
111	(1) That portion of State Road 944 on N.W. 54th Street
112	between U.S. Highway 1 and N.E. 2nd Avenue in Miami-Dade County
113	is designated as "Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard."
114	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
115	suitable markers designating Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard as
116	described in subsection (1).
117	(3) Section 6 of chapter 2003-296, Laws of Florida, is
118	repealed.
119	Section 10. A.B. Martin Street designated; Department of
120	Transportation to erect suitable markers
121	(1) That portion of N.W. 135th Street between N.W. 27th
122	Avenue and N.W. 37th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated

127	Section 11. Leighton Lee Baker Memorial Highway
128	designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable

130	(1) That portion of Old U.S. Highway 441 between David
131	Walker Drive and Eudora Road in Lake County is designated as

"Leighton Lee Baker Memorial Highway."

134	suitable markers designating Leighton Lee Baker Memorial Highway
135	as described in subsection (1).
136	Section 12. Trinchitella Boulevard designated; Department
137	of Transportation to erect suitable markers
138	(1) That portion of S.W. 10th Street between F.A.U.
139	Research Park Boulevard and the Sawgrass Expressway in the City
140	of Deerfield Beach in Broward County is designated as
141	"Trinchitella Boulevard."
142	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
143	suitable markers designating Trinchitella Boulevard as described
144	in subsection (1).
145	Section 13. John Van Waters Memorial Highway designated;
146	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers
147	(1) That portion of State Road 35 from County Road 35A
148	north to the Pasco County line in Pasco County is designated as
149	"John Van Waters Memorial Highway."
150	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
151	suitable markers designating John Van Waters Memorial Highway as
152	described in subsection (1).
153	Section 14. Emilio Ochoa Boulevard designated; Department
154	of Transportation to erect suitable markers
155	(1) That portion of Calle Ocho (S.W. 8th Street) between
156	S.W. 87th Avenue and S.W. 97th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is
157	designated as "Emilio Ochoa Boulevard."

158	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
159	suitable markers designating Emilio Ochoa Boulevard as described
160	in subsection (1).
161	Section 15. Eddie Mae Steward Avenue designated;
162	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers
163	(1) That portion of Main Street between West 6th Street
164	and West 8th Street in Duval County is designated as "Eddie Mae
165	Steward Avenue."
166	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
167	suitable markers designating Eddie Mae Steward Avenue as
168	described in subsection (1).
169	Section 16. Mary L. Austin Jones Avenue designated;
170	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers
171	(1) That portion of Main Street between West 37th Street
172	and West 46th Street in Duval County is designated as "Mary L.
173	Austin Jones Avenue."
174	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
175	suitable markers designating Mary L. Austin Jones Avenue as
176	described in subsection (1).
177	Section 17. Flossie Brunson Avenue designated; Department
178	of Transportation to erect suitable markers
179	(1) That portion of Main Street between West 8th Street
180	and West 18th Street in Duval County is designated as "Flossie
181	Brunson Avenue."
182	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
183	suitable markers designating Flossie Brunson Avenue as described
184	in subsection (1).

L96	and Edgewood Avenue in Duval County is designated as "Barbara
L97	Van Blake Parkway."
L98	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
L99	suitable markers designating Barbara Van Blake Parkway as
200	described in subsection (1).
201	Section 20. MaVynne "The Beach Lady" Betsch Highway
202	designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
203	markers
204	(1) That portion of Florida First Coast Highway beginning
205	at Burney Road and continuing north through the 5500 block of
206	Florida First Coast Highway in Nassau County is designated as
207	"MaVynne 'The Beach Lady' Betsch Highway."
802	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
209	suitable markers designating MaVynne "The Beach Lady" Betsch

Highway as described in subsection (1).

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211	Section 21. Brian D. Little Road designated; Department of
212	Transportation to erect suitable markers
213	(1) That portion of State Road 188 between State Road 189
214	and State Road 85 in Okaloosa County is designated as "Brian D.
215	Little Road."
216	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
217	suitable markers designating Brian D. Little Road as described
218	in subsection (1).
219	Section 22. John Land Apopka Expressway designated;
220	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers
221	(1) That portion of State Road 414 known as Maitland
222	Boulevard that extends west from U.S. Highway 441 to the City of
223	Apopka before heading north to U.S. Highway 441 near County Road
224	437, which is commonly known as Maitland Boulevard Extension, is
225	designated as "John Land Apopka Expressway."
226	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
227	suitable markers designating John Land Apopka Expressway as
228	described in subsection (1).
229	Section 23. George C. Means Memorial Bridge designated;
230	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers
231	(1) The replacement bridge over Lake Jesup on State Road
232	46 near Sanford designated as the "George C. Means Memorial
233	Bridge."
234	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
235	suitable markers designating the George C. Means Memorial Bridge
236	as described in subsection (1).

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237	Section 24. Patrick D. Smith Causeway designated;
238	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers
239	(1) The portion of State Road 520 in Brevard County which
240	is between mile post 13.2 and mile post 15.3 and lies
241	approximately between the West Banana River and Cape Canaveral
242	Hospital is designated as the "Patrick D. Smith Causeway."
243	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
244	suitable markers designating the Patrick D. Smith Causeway as
245	described in subsection (1).
246	Section 25. Charles M. Parker Bridge designated;
247	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers
248	(1) The Canal Park Bridge on U.S. Highway 98 in the City
249	of Mexico Beach in Bay County is designated as the "Charles M.
250	Parker Bridge."
251	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
252	suitable markers designating the Charles M. Parker Bridge as
253	described in subsection (1).
254	Section 26. Rosa Parks Memorial Highway designated;
255	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers
256	(1) That portion of U.S. Highway 301 from State Road 40 in
257	Marion County through the City of Waldo in Alachua County is
258	designated as "Rosa Parks Memorial Highway."
259	(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
260	suitable markers designating Rosa Parks Memorial Highway as
261	described in subsection (1).
262	Section 27. Veterans Memorial Parkway designated;
263	Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers

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(1) That portion of U.S. 41 in the City of Jasper in
Hamilton County from its intersection with U.S. 129 to the
southern city limit is designated as "Veterans Memorial
Parkway."
(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
suitable markers designating Veterans Memorial Parkway as
described in subsection (1).
Section 28. Austin Dewey Gay Memorial Agricultural
Inspection Station designated; Department of Agriculture and
Consumer Services to erect suitable markers
(1) The inspection station of the Department of
Agriculture and Consumer Services which is located at the 1-mile
marker on Interstate Highway 10 in Escambia County is designated
as the "Austin Dewey Gay Memorial Agricultural Inspection
Station."
(2) The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services is
directed to erect suitable markers designating the Austin Dewey
Gay Memorial Agricultural Inspection Station as described in
subsection (1)

Section 29. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
