

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to voter registration; amending s.
 3 372.574, F.S.; requiring subagents appointed by the Fish
 4 and Wildlife Conservation Commission for the sale of
 5 hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses and permits to
 6 provide individuals seeking such licenses and permits the
 7 opportunity to register to vote or to update a voter
 8 registration; requiring supervisors of elections to
 9 provide such subagents with the necessary voter
 10 registration applications; providing penalties; providing
 11 an effective date.

 13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 15 Section 1. Subsection (4) is added to section 372.574,
 16 Florida Statutes, to read:

17 372.574 Appointment of subagents for the sale of hunting,
 18 fishing, and trapping licenses and permits; voter registration
 19 duties.--

20 (4)(a) All subagents appointed under this section shall
 21 provide the opportunity to register to vote or to update a voter
 22 registration record to each individual who comes to the subagent
 23 to purchase any resident hunting license, fishing license,
 24 combination license, or trapping permit. Each subagent shall
 25 provide each individual with a voter registration application,
 26 which shall be provided to the subagent by the voter
 27 registration office in the subagent's county.

28 (b) Within 30 days after the effective date of this act,

29 each supervisor of elections shall provide an appropriate supply
30 of voter registration applications to each subagent in that
31 supervisor's county and thereafter at the request of the
32 subagent along with appropriate contact information for each
33 subagent to request additional applications.

34 (c) Failure to comply with any provision of this
35 subsection by any subagent or supervisor of elections shall
36 constitute a civil infraction subject to a minimum fine of \$500
37 for the first infraction, \$1,000 for the second infraction, and
38 \$2,500 for each subsequent infraction.

39 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
