It is the intent of this act to establish a statewide pilot program that will allocate \$15 million from 26 27 general revenue for such purposes. 28 The Small Business Health Care Insurance Assistance (2) 29 Pilot Program is created as a statewide pilot program for a 30 period of 2 years to provide a one-time rebate for small 31 businesses that employ more than one but fewer than six employees and that provide full coverage of comprehensive major 32 medical health insurance for such employees pursuant to s. 33 34 627.6699, Florida Statutes. The employer shall pay at least 50 35 percent but less than 100 percent of the cost of the coverage, 36 and the employees must share in the remainder of the cost of the 37 coverage. 38 (3) (a) The amount of the rebate shall be \$1,000 per each 39 employee as reported on the business' Florida unemployment 40 compensation tax form 6. 41 (b) A small business must apply through the Agency for 42 Health Care Administration. (c) A business is eligible for the rebate under this 43 section if, at the time of applying for a rebate under the pilot 4445 program, the business had provided and paid for such coverage 46 for 12 consecutive months but had not provided and paid for such 47 coverage for at least 6 months prior to such 12-month period. The business may receive the rebate only one time. 48 The pilot program shall be funded by general revenue 49 (4) 50 and shall be administered by the Agency for Health Care 51 Administration.
