**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Between lines 61 and 62,

insert:

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 20.201, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

20.201 Department of Law Enforcement.--

(1) There is created a Department of Law Enforcement.

The head of the department is the Governor and Cabinet. The executive director of the department shall be appointed by the Governor and ~~with the approval of three members of the Cabinet~~ and subject to confirmation by the Senate. The executive director shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor and Cabinet. The executive director may establish a command, operational, and administrative services structure to assist, manage, and support the department in operating programs and delivering services.
