The term includes buildings not intended for human habitation such as 3 lawn storage buildings and storage sheds manufactured and 4 5 assembled offsite by a manufacturer certified in conformance б with this part. This part does not apply to mobile homes. The 7 foundation systems set forth in rules 15C-1 and 15C-2, Florida 8 Administrative Code, are acceptable systems for all types of manufactured buildings. 9 10 Section 2. Subsection (12) is added to 553.37, Florida 11 Statutes, to read: 12 553.37 Rules; inspections; and insignia.--(12) <u>A manufactured building that otherwise complies</u> 13 with this part and that is intended to be used for 2 years or 14 less shall be permitted to use a foundation system designed 15 and installed in accordance with the standards adopted 16 17 pursuant to s. 320.8325(1). Use of the building shall be 18 extended for an additional 2 years upon application to the authority having jurisdiction and an inspection of the 19 foundation system to determine its integrity and ability to 2.0 21 perform.
