A bill to be entitled

An act relating to vehicular accidents involving death or personal injuries; amending s. 316.027, F.S.; creating the "Wilkins-Caldwell Act"; requiring a court to sentence a driver of a vehicle to a minimum term of imprisonment if the driver leaves the scene of a crash that results in death or personal injuries and the driver does not report to a law enforcement agency within a specified period of time; amending ss. 318.13, 318.14, 318.18, 921.0022, and 960.03, F.S.; conforming cross-references; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 316.027, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.027 Crash involving death or personal injuries.-(1) This section may be cited as the "Wilkins-Caldwell
Act."

(2)(1)(a) The driver of any vehicle involved in a crash resulting in injury of any person must immediately stop the vehicle at the scene of the crash, or as close thereto as possible, and must remain at the scene of the crash until he or she has fulfilled the requirements of s. 316.062. Any person who willfully violates this paragraph commits is guilty of a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. A driver who willfully violates this paragraph by leaving the scene of the crash and not reporting to

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a law enforcement agency within 24 hours after the crash shall be sentenced to a minimum mandatory period of incarceration of 2 years.

- (b) The driver of any vehicle involved in a crash resulting in the death of any person must immediately stop the vehicle at the scene of the crash, or as close thereto as possible, and must remain at the scene of the crash until he or she has fulfilled the requirements of s. 316.062. Any person who willfully violates this paragraph commits is guilty of a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. A driver who willfully violates this paragraph by leaving the scene of the crash and not reporting to a law enforcement agency within 24 hours after the crash shall be sentenced to a minimum mandatory period of incarceration of 4 years.
- $\underline{(3)}$  The department shall revoke the driver's license of the person so convicted.
- (4)(3) Every stop must be made without obstructing traffic more than is necessary, and, if a damaged vehicle is obstructing traffic, the driver of the vehicle must make every reasonable effort to move the vehicle or have it moved so as not to obstruct the regular flow of traffic. Any person who fails to comply with this subsection shall be cited for a nonmoving violation, punishable as provided in chapter 318.
- (5) (4) A person whose commission of a noncriminal traffic infraction or any violation of this chapter or s. 1006.66 causes or results in the death of another person may, in addition to any other civil, criminal, or administrative penalty imposed, be

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required by the court to serve 120 community service hours in a trauma center or hospital that regularly receives victims of vehicle accidents, under the supervision of a registered nurse, an emergency room physician, or an emergency medical technician pursuant to a voluntary community service program operated by the trauma center or hospital.

Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 318.13, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

- 318.13 Definitions.--The following words and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section, except where the context otherwise requires:
- (3) "Infraction" means a noncriminal violation that may require community service hours under s. 316.027(5)(4), but is not punishable by incarceration and for which there is no right to a trial by jury or a right to court-appointed counsel.
- Section 3. Subsection (1) of section 318.14, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 318.14 Noncriminal traffic infractions; exception; procedures.--
- (1) Except as provided in ss. 318.17 and 320.07(3)(c), any person cited for a violation of chapter 316, s. 320.0605, s. 320.07(3)(a) or (b), s. 322.065, s. 322.15(1), s. 322.16(2) or (3), s. 322.161(5), s. 322.19, or s. 1006.66(3) is charged with a noncriminal infraction and must be cited for such an infraction and cited to appear before an official. If another person dies as a result of the noncriminal infraction, the person cited may be required to perform 120 community service

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hours under s. 316.027(5)(4), in addition to any other penalties.

Section 4. Paragraph (c) of subsection (8) of section 318.18, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

318.18 Amount of civil penalties.--The penalties required for a noncriminal disposition pursuant to s. 318.14 are as follows:

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(c) If the noncriminal infraction has caused or resulted in the death of another, the person who committed the infraction may perform 120 community service hours under s. 316.027(5)(4), in addition to any other penalties.
