Additionally, a licensee who fails to file a renewal application on or before 3 its expiration date must renew his or her license by paying a late fee of \$15. A No license may not shall be renewed 180 5 days 6 months or more after its expiration date, and such a 7 license is shall be deemed to be permanently expired. If the license-renewal requirements in 21 22 paragraph (a) are met within the 180-day extension period, the 23 servicemember may not be charged any additional costs, such 2.4 as, but not limited to, late fees or delinquency fees, above the normal license fees. The servicemember must present to the 25 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services a copy of his 26 or her official military orders or a written verification from 27 28 the member's commanding officer before the end of the 180-day 29 period in order to qualify for the extension.
