Subsection (11) of section 790.06, Florida 16 17 Statutes, is amended to read: 790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.--18 (11) No less than 90 days before prior to the 19 expiration date of the license, the Department of Agriculture 20 21 and Consumer Services shall mail to each licensee a written 22 notice of the expiration and a renewal form prescribed by the 23 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. The licensee must renew his or her license on or before the expiration date 2.4 by filing with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer 25 Services the renewal form containing a notarized affidavit 26 27 stating that the licensee remains qualified pursuant to the 2.8 criteria specified in subsections (2) and (3), a color 29 photograph as specified in paragraph (5)(e), and the required renewal fee. The license 8 shall be renewed upon receipt of the completed renewal form, 9 color photograph, appropriate payment of fees, and, if applicable, a completed fingerprint card. Additionally, a 10 licensee who fails to file a renewal application on or before 11 12 its expiration date must renew his or her license by paying a 13 late fee of \$15. <u>A</u> No license <u>may not</u> shall be renewed 6 14 months or more after its expiration date, and this such license is shall be deemed to be permanently expired.
