The licensee must renew his or her license on or before the expiration date 2.4 by filing with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer 25 Services the renewal form containing a notarized affidavit 26 27 stating that the licensee remains qualified pursuant to the 28 criteria specified in subsections (2) and (3), a color 29 photograph as specified in paragraph (5)(e), and the required renewal fee.
