On page 3, between lines 4 and 5,

insert:

Section 3. Section 117.10, Florida Statutes, is
amended to read:

117.10 Law enforcement and correctional officers.--Law
enforcement officers, correctional officers, and correctional
probation officers, as defined in s. 943.10, and traffic
accident investigation officers and traffic infraction
enforcement officers, as described in s. 316.640, are
authorized to administer oaths when engaged in the performance
of official duties. Sections 117.01, 117.04, 117.045, 117.05,
117.071, and 117.103 do not apply to the provisions of this
section. An officer may not notarize his or her own
signature.
