House Joint Resolution A joint resolution proposing an amendment to Section 4 of Article IV of the State Constitution to create the position of Insurance Commissioner as an elected member of the Cabinet, the creation of Section 8 of Article VI of the State Constitution to prohibit certain campaign contributions relating to candidates for the office of Insurance Commissioner, and the creation of Section 26 of Article XII of the State Constitution to provide an effective date for such changes and for the initial election to such office. Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: That the following amendment to Section 4 of Article IV and the creation of Section 8 of Article VI and Section 26 of Article XII of the State Constitution are agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose: ARTICLE IV EXECUTIVE SECTION 4. Cabinet. --There shall be a cabinet composed of an attorney (a) general, a chief financial officer, and a commissioner of agriculture, and an insurance commissioner. In addition to the powers and duties specified herein, they shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as may be prescribed by law. In Page 1 of 5

The attorney general shall be the chief state legal 31 (b) officer. There is created in the office of the attorney general 32 the position of statewide prosecutor.
