17 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

19 Section 1. Section 514.072, Florida Statutes, is created  
20 to read:

21 514.072 Certification of swimming instructors for people  
22 who have developmental disabilities required.--Any person  
23 working at a swimming pool who holds himself or herself out as a

24 swimming instructor specializing in training people who have  
25 developmental disabilities, as defined in s. 393.063(10), may be  
26 certified by the Dan Marino Foundation, Inc., in addition to  
27 being certified under s. 514.071. The Dan Marino Foundation,  
28 Inc., must develop certification requirements and a training  
29 curriculum for swimming instructors for people who have  
30 developmental disabilities and must submit the certification  
31 requirements to the Department of Health for review by January  
32 1, 2007. A person certified under s. 514.071 before July 1,  
33 2007, must meet the additional certification requirements of  
34 this section before January 1, 2008. A person certified under s.  
35 514.071 on or after July 1, 2007, must meet the additional  
36 certification requirements of this section within 6 months after  
37 receiving certification under s. 514.071.

38 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006, only  
39 if a specific appropriation to the Department of Health to fund  
40 the Dan Marino Foundation, Inc., is made in the General  
41 Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2006-2007.
