10 (1) Notwithstanding s. 322.28, the court shall order
11 the department to withhold the issuance of, or suspend or
12 revoke, the driver's license of a person 21 years or age or
13 older, other than a licensee or an employee or agent of a
14 licensee who is found guilty of a violation of s.
15 562.11(1)(a), for not less than 3 months more than 6 months
16 for a violation and 1 year for any subsequent violation.

17 (2) The court may direct the department to issue a
18 driver's license restricted to business or employment purposes
19 only, as provided in s. 322.271, to a person who is otherwise
20 qualified for a license.

21 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
