Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause

and insert:

Section 1. The Florida Building Commission may update or modify the wind-design standard applicable to construction in this state as adopted within the Florida Building Code in accordance with the requirements of s. 553.73, Florida Statutes. The Florida Building Commission is specifically authorized to identify within the Florida Building Code those areas of the state from the eastern border of Franklin County west to the Florida-Alabama line which are subject to the windborne-debris requirements of the code. The Florida Building Commission's initial designation of wind lines for this region shall address the results of the study required by section 39 of chapter 2005-147, Laws of Florida. The initial designation of those areas after July 1, 2006, is subject to only the rule-adoption procedures of chapter 120, Florida
