12	Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 489.113, Florida								
13	Statutes, is amended to read:

15	(2) No person who is not certified or registered shall								
16	engage in the business of contracting in this state. However,								
17	for purposes of complying with the provisions of this chapter, a								
18	person who is not certified or registered may perform								
19	construction work under the supervision of a person who is								
20	certified or registered, <u>or under the supervision of the owner</u>								
21	of the property who is acting as his or her own contractor								
22	pursuant to s. 489.103(7), provided that the work is within the								
23	scope of the certified or registered supervisor's license and								
24	provided that the person being supervised is not engaged in								
25	construction work which would require a license as a contractor								
26	under any of the categories listed in s. 489.105(3)(d)-(o). This								
27	subsection does not affect the application of any local

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29 The department shall issue a cease and desist order to (a) 30 prohibit any person from engaging in the business of contracting who does not hold the required certification or registration for 31 32 the work being performed under this part. For the purpose of enforcing a cease and desist order, the department may file a 33 proceeding in the name of the state seeking issuance of an 34 35 injunction or a writ of mandamus against any person who violates any provision of such order. 36

(b) A county, municipality, or local licensing board created by special act may issue a cease and desist order to prohibit any person from engaging in the business of contracting who does not hold the required certification or registration for the work being performed under this part.

Any person who is not required to obtain registration 46 (e) 47 or certification pursuant to s. 489.105(3)(d)-(o) may perform specialty contracting services for the construction, remodeling, 48 49 repair, or improvement of single-family residences, including a 50 townhouse as defined in the Florida Building Code, without obtaining a local professional license if such person is under 51 the supervision of a certified or registered general, building, 52 or residential contractor or is under the supervision of the 53 54 owner of the property who is acting as his or her own contractor pursuant to s. 489.103(7). As used in this paragraph, 55 supervision shall not be deemed to require the existence of a 56

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57 direct contract between the certified or registered general,

58 building, or residential contractor and the person performing
