12	Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 121.0515, Florida
13	Statutes, is amended to read:
14	121.0515 Special risk membership
15	(2) CRITERIAA member, to be designated as a special
16	risk member, must meet the following criteria:
17	(a) The member must be employed as a law enforcement
18	officer and be certified, or required to be certified, in
19	compliance with s. 943.1395; however, sheriffs and elected
20	police chiefs shall be excluded from meeting the certification
21	requirements of this paragraph. In addition, the member's
22	duties and responsibilities must include the pursuit,
23	apprehension, and arrest of law violators or suspected law
24	violators; or the member must be an active member of a bomb
25	disposal unit whose primary responsibility is the location,
26	handling, and disposal of explosive devices; or the member
27	must be the supervisor or command officer of a member or
28	members who have such responsibilities; provided, however,
29	administrative support personnel, including, but not limited
30	to, those whose primary duties and responsibilities are in

accounting, purchasing, legal, and personnel, shall not be included;

- (b) The member must be employed as a firefighter and be certified, or required to be certified, in compliance with s. 633.35 and be employed solely within the fire department of a local government employer or an agency of state government with firefighting responsibilities. In addition, the member's duties and responsibilities must include on-the-scene fighting of fires, fire prevention, or firefighter training; direct supervision of firefighting units, fire prevention, or firefighter training; or aerial firefighting surveillance performed by fixed-wing aircraft pilots employed by the Division of Forestry of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; or the member must be the supervisor or command officer of a member or members who have such responsibilities; provided, however, administrative support personnel, including, but not limited to, those whose primary duties and responsibilities are in accounting, purchasing, legal, and personnel, shall not be included and further provided that all periods of creditable service in fire prevention or firefighter training, or as the supervisor or command officer of a member or members who have such responsibilities, and for which the employer paid the special risk contribution rate, shall be included;
- officer and be certified, or required to be certified, in compliance with s. 943.1395. In addition, the member's primary duties and responsibilities must be the custody, and physical restraint when necessary, of prisoners or inmates within a prison, jail, or other criminal detention facility, or while on work detail outside the facility, or while being

officer of a member or members who have such responsibilities;

provided, however, administrative support personnel,
including, but not limited to, those whose primary duties and
responsibilities are in accounting, purchasing, legal, and
personnel, shall not be included; however, wardens and
assistant wardens, as defined by rule, shall participate in
the Special Risk Class;

- Life Support (ALS) or Basic Life Support (BLS) employer as an emergency medical technician or a paramedic and be certified in compliance with s. 401.27. In addition, the member's primary duties and responsibilities must include on-the-scene emergency medical care or direct supervision of emergency medical technicians or paramedics, or the member must be the supervisor or command officer of one or more members who have such responsibility. However, administrative support personnel, including, but not limited to, those whose primary responsibilities are in accounting, purchasing, legal, and personnel, shall not be included;
- (e) The member must be employed as a community-based correctional probation officer and be certified, or required to be certified, in compliance with s. 943.1395. In addition, the member's primary duties and responsibilities must be the supervised custody, surveillance, control, investigation, and counseling of assigned inmates, probationers, parolees, or community controllees within the community; or the member must be the supervisor of a member or members who have such responsibilities. Administrative support personnel, including, but not limited to, those whose primary duties and responsibilities are in accounting, purchasing, legal

but not limited to, those whose primary responsibilities are clerical or in accounting, purchasing, legal, and personnel, 2 3 shall not be included; or. 4 (i) The member must be employed by a county, municipality, or district law enforcement or fire services 5 6 agency as an emergency dispatcher. The member's primary duties 7 and responsibilities must include reception of emergency calls 8 for service; coordination of the direction and placement of field units to strategic locations for critical incidents; 9 10 prioritization of calls for service; selection of assignments and dispatch of emergency and nonemergency calls via radio 11 12 communication technology to county, municipal, intercounty, 13 and federal personnel using the assigned talk groups while monitoring the safety status of all field units; and 14 coordination of the movements of multiple emergency units 15 engaged in pursuit tactics or responding to life or death 16 situations or the member must be the direct supervisor or 18 command officer of one or more individuals with such responsibilities. 19 Section 2. The Legislature finds that a proper and 2.0 21 legitimate state purpose is served when employees and retirees of the state and of its political subdivisions, and the 2.2 23 dependents, survivors, and beneficiaries of such employees and retirees, are extended the basic protections afforded by 2.4 governmental retirement systems that provide fair and adequate 2.5 benefits and that are managed, administered, and funded in an 26 27 actuarially sound manner as required by s. 14, Art. X of the 2.8 State Constitution and part VII of chapter 112, Florida Statutes. Therefore, the Legislature determines and declares 29 that this act fulfills an important state interest. 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2006. 31
