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Section 5. All public roads and the public rights-of-way associated therewith, on the Broward County road system, lying within the limits of the lands subject to annexation herein, are transferred from Broward County jurisdiction to the jurisdiction of the annexing municipality.

Section 6. On the effective date of this act, the City of Lauderhill shall be responsible for and embodied with all municipal powers granted in chapter 166, Florida Statutes, including, but not limited to, police powers and fire and emergency services, over territory hereby annexed.

Section 7. Nothing in this act shall be construed to affect or abrogate the rights of parties to any contracts, or between nongovernmental entities, which contracts are in effect prior to the effective date of the annexation.

Section 8. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
