Between lines 83 and 84,

insert:

Section 5. Section 627.747, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

627.747 Motor vehicle insurance inspections.--All preinsurance inspections required by this chapter for the issuance of motor vehicle insurance policies performed in a county having a 2004 estimated population in excess of 50,000 shall include two color images at oblique angles, clearly showing all four sides of the vehicle and any observable prior damage, and taking one color image of the Motor Vehicle Safety Standard Label, which includes the vehicle identification number. The term "color image" means any acceptable technology producing a clear visual image in color, including, but not limited to, an instant type photograph, a photograph using the film process, or a digital photograph or other digital-imaging process that may be accessed, stored, and retrieved
