10	approval, a strategic plan that includes, but is not limited to,
11	the following:
12	(a) A list of the community colleges to be converted to
13	Level II institutions and a rationale in support of the
14	designation of each institution on the list.
15	(b) A funding plan that makes reference to the percentages
16	of general revenue that have been allocated in the past to the
17	several sectors of education and how the general revenue shall
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18 be allocated in the future in order to provide funding in support of the emerging 4-year colleges. 19 (c) An accountability program, including a standardized 20 test to ensure that students entering upper-division programs at 21 Level II institutions have the necessary prerequisite academic 22 skills to be successful in upper-division courses. The 23 standardized test requirement shall not be waived; however, 24 25 appropriate accommodations shall be provided for students with 26 documented disabilities. (d) Provisions for effective coordination between the 27 28 Chancellor of the Division of Community Colleges and the Chancellor of the State University System concerning the 29 development of baccalaureate degree programs. 30 (e) Provisions for the solicitation and evaluation of 31 proposals for the conduct by state universities and independent 32 colleges and universities of baccalaureate degree programs on 33 community college campuses, to include the evaluative criteria 34 among which must be cost to the state. 35 (f) Provisions to ensure that the community colleges 36 converted to Level II institutions maintain their traditional 37 community college mission, to include a specific limit on the 38 39 percentage of degrees at the baccalaureate level awarded in any calendar year. 40 The strategic plan shall be forwarded to the President 41 (2) of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on 42 or before December 31, 2006. 43 Section 2.
