**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 2, between lines 15 and 16,

insert:

Section 2. Present subsection (7) of section 322.051, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (8), and new subsection (7) is added to that section to read:

322.051 Identification cards.--

(7) Any veteran honorably discharged from the Armed Forces who has been issued a valid identification card by the Department of Veterans' Affairs in accordance with s. 295.17, or has been determined by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or its predecessor to have a 100-percent total and permanent service-connected disability rating for compensation, or has been determined to have a service-connected total and permanent disability rating of 100 percent and is in receipt of disability retirement pay from any branch of the United States Armed Services, and who is

 2 is exempt from all fees required by this section.  
 3 Additionally, any honorably discharged veteran 60 years of age  
 4 or older who is otherwise qualified to obtain an
