(Haridopolos) recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 17, between lines 30 and 31,

insert:

Section 15. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section  
500.12, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

500.12 Food permits; building permits.--

(1)(a) A food permit from the department is required  
of any person who operates a food establishment or retail food  
store, except:

1. Persons operating minor food outlets, including,  
but not limited to, video stores, that sell commercially  
prepackaged, nonpotentially hazardous candy, chewing gum,  
soda, or popcorn, provided the shelf space for those items  
does not exceed 12 linear feet and no other food is sold by  
the minor food outlet.

2. Persons subject to continuous, onsite federal or  
state inspection.

1           3. Persons selling only legumes in the shell, either  
2 parched, roasted, or boiled.

3           4. Persons selling sugar cane or sorghum syrup that  
4 has been boiled and bottled on a premise located within the  
5 state. Such bottles must contain a label listing the  
6 producer's name and address and all added ingredients, and a  
7 statement that reads, "This product has not been produced in a  
8 facility permitted by the Florida Department of Agriculture  
9 and Consumer Services".
