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The Committee on Health Care (Peaden) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment

On page 5, line 14, through page 6, line 10, delete those lines

and insert:

(6) In addition to the immunity granted in subsection (5), managed care organization employees or contractors whose responsibilities include the investigation and disposition of claims relating to suspected fraudulent or abusive acts may share information relating to persons suspected of committing fraudulent or abusive acts with other managed care organizations' employees or contractors, of the same or other managed care organization, whose responsibilities include the investigation and disposition of claims relating to fraudulent or abusive acts. A person or managed care organization is not subject to civil liability, of any nature, absent proof by clear and convincing evidence of a specific intent to harm a person or entity that is the subject of information-sharing or

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1 reporting under the provisions of this subsection.

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
