Section 7. Subsection (3) is added to section 627.6402, Florida Statutes, to read:

627.6402 Insurance rebates for healthy lifestyles.--

- (3) In addition to the outline of coverage, a policy as specified in s. 627.6699(3)(k) must be accompanied by an identification card that contains, at a minimum:
- (a) The name of the organization issuing the policy or the name of the organization administering the policy, whichever applies.
 - (b) The name of the contract holder.
- (c) The type of plan only if the plan is filed in the state, an indication that the plan is self-funded, or the name of the network.

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- (d) The member identification number, contract number, and policy or group number, if applicable.
- (e) A contact phone number or electronic address for authorizations.
- (f) A phone number or electronic address by which the covered person or hospital, physician, or other person rendering services covered by the policy may determine if the plan is insured and may obtain a benefits verification in order to estimate patient financial responsibility, in compliance with privacy rules under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996.
- (g) The national plan identifier, in accordance with the compliance date set forth by the United States Department of Health and Human Services. The identification card must present the information in a readily identifiable manner or the information may be embedded on the card and available through magnetic stripe or smart card. The information may also be provided through other electronic technology.
- Section 8. Subsection (2) of section 627.657, Florida Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (3), and a new subsection (2) is added to that section, to read:
 - 627.657 Provisions of group health insurance policies.--
- (2) The medical policy as specified in s. 627.6699(3)(k) must be accompanied by an identification card that contains, at a minimum:
- (a) The name of the organization issuing the policy or name of the organization administering the policy, whichever applies.

- (c) The type of plan only if the plan is filed in the state, an indication that the plan is self-funded, or the name of the network.
- (d) The member identification number, contract number, and policy or group number, if applicable.
- (e) A contact phone number or electronic address for authorizations.
- (f) A phone number or electronic address by which the covered person or hospital, physician, or other person rendering services covered by the policy may determine if the plan is insured and may obtain a benefits verification in order to estimate patient financial responsibility, in compliance with privacy rules under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996.
- (g) The national plan identifier, in accordance with the compliance date set forth by the United States Department of Health and Human Services.

Section 9. Subsection (41) is added to section 641.31, Florida Statutes, to read:

- 641.31 Health maintenance contracts.--
- (41) The contract, certificate, or member handbook must be accompanied by an identification card that contains, at a minimum:

- (a) The name of the organization offering the contract or name of the organization administering the contract, whichever applies.
 - (b) The name of the subscriber.
- (c) A statement that the health plan is a health maintenance organization. Only a health plan with a certificate of authority issued under this chapter may be identified as a health maintenance organization.
- (d) The member identification number, contract number, and group number, if applicable.
- (e) A contact phone number or electronic address for authorizations.
- (f) A phone number or electronic address by which the covered person or hospital, physician, or other person rendering services covered by the contract may determine if the plan is insured and may obtain a benefits verification in order to estimate patient financial responsibility, in compliance with privacy rules under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996.
- (g) The national plan identifier, in accordance with the compliance date set forth by the United States Department of Health and Human Services.
