A bill to be entitled

An act relating to motorcycles; amending s.
316.2095, F.S.; deleting a requirement that
certain motorcycles be equipped with passenger
handholds; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 316.2095, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

316.2095 Footrests, handholds, and handlebars.--

(1) Any motorcycle carrying a passenger, other than in
a sidecar or enclosed cab, shall be equipped with footrests
~~and handholds~~ for such passenger.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.

SENATE SUMMARY

Deletes a requirement that certain motorcycles be
equipped with handholds for passengers.
