30 <u>(6)(5)</u> It is a misdemeanor of the second degree, 31 punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, for any 32 person to operate a motor vehicle in any manner in violation of 33 the restrictions imposed in a license issued to him or her 34 except for a violation of paragraph (1)(d), subsection (2), or 35 subsection (3), or subsection (4).

36 <u>(7)(6)</u> Any person who operates a motor vehicle in 37 violation of the restrictions imposed in subsection (2), or 38 subsection (3), or subsection (4) commits a noncriminal traffic 39 <u>infraction, punishable as will be charged with a moving</u> 40 violation <u>as provided in and fined in accordance with</u> chapter 41 318.
