Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 316.027, Florida  
<A NAME="PagelLiA">19 Statutes, is amended, and subsection (5) is added to  
that

section, to read:

316.027 Crash involving death or personal injuries.--

(1)(a) The driver of any vehicle involved in a crash  
occurring on public or private property that results ~~resulting~~  
in injury of any person must immediately stop the vehicle at  
the scene of the crash, or as close thereto as possible, and  
must remain at the scene of the crash until he or she has  
fulfilled the requirements of s. 316.062. Any person who  
willfully violates this paragraph commits ~~is guilty of~~ a  
felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s.  
775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

(b) The driver of any vehicle involved in a crash

1 occurring on public or private property that results ~~resulting~~  
2 in the death of any person must immediately stop the vehicle  
3 at the scene of the crash, or as close thereto as possible,  
4 and must remain at the scene of the crash until he or she has

6 willfully violates this paragraph commits ~~is guilty of~~ a  
7 felony of the first ~~second~~ degree, punishable as provided in  
8 s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

9 (5) This section does not apply to crashes occurring  
10 during a motorsports event, as defined in s. 549.10(1), or at  
11 a closed-course motorsport facility, as defined in s.  
12 549.09(1).
