No later than January 1, 2007, the Florida Alliance of Information and Referral Services shall provide a statewide 8 report to the agency that includes the individual reports and 9 10 aggregated data provided by the 211 providers. 11 3. No later than January 15, 2007, the agency shall submit a report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, 12 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives detailing 13 expenditure of the funds appropriated to it for the purposes 14 15 of this subsection. (4) As used in this section, the term "211 provider" 16 means an information and referral organization the primary 17 purpose of which is to maintain information about human 18 19 service resources in the community, supply descriptive 20 information about the agencies or organizations that offer 21 services, and assist consumers in accessing appropriate 22 providers. Section 2. The sum of \$5 million is appropriated for 23 2.4 the 2006-2007 fiscal year from nonrecurring general revenue to the Agency for Health Care Administration to fund the 25 statewide expansion of the Florida 211 Network to all counties 26 and to enhance the operations of existing 211 providers under 27 s. 408.918, Florida Statutes, as amended by this act. Any 28 29 funds that are not encumbered for the 2006-2007 fiscal year shall revert on June 30, 2007, and are reappropriated for the 30 2007-2008 fiscal year for the same purposes.
