

1 A bill to be entitled

2 An act relating to specialty license plates; amending s.
3 320.08056, F.S.; revising specialty license plate use fee
4 provisions to change a name; establishing an annual use
5 fee for the Homeownership For All license plate; exempting
6 collegiate license plates from discontinuance
7 requirements; amending s. 320.08058, F.S.; revising
8 authorized uses of the use fees received from sales of the
9 Keep Kids Drug-Free license plate; changing the name of
10 the Florida Memorial College license plate to the Florida
11 Memorial University license plate; revising authorized
12 uses of the use fees received from sales of the
13 Sportsmen's National Land Trust license plate; creating
14 the Homeownership For All license plate and providing for
15 distribution of the fees received from sales of the plate;
16 amending s. 320.0807, F.S.; creating special license
17 plates for legislative presiding officers; providing an
18 effective date.

20 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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22 Section 1. Paragraph (z) of subsection (4) and paragraph
23 (a) of subsection (8) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes,
24 are amended, and paragraph (eee) is added to subsection (4) of
25 that section, to read:

26 320.08056 Specialty license plates.--

27 (4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be
 28 collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

29 (z) Florida Memorial University ~~College~~ license plate,
 30 \$25.

31 (eee) Homeownership For All license plate, \$25.

32 (8) (a) The department must discontinue the issuance of an
 33 approved specialty license plate if the number of valid
 34 specialty plate registrations falls below 1,000 plates for at
 35 least 12 consecutive months. A warning letter shall be mailed to
 36 the sponsoring organization following the first month in which
 37 the total number of valid specialty plate registrations is below
 38 1,000 plates. The provisions of this subsection do not apply to
 39 collegiate license plates established pursuant to s.

40 320.08058(3).

41 Section 2. Subsections (23), (26), and (48) of section
 42 320.08058, Florida Statutes, are amended, and subsection (57) is
 43 added to that section, to read:

44 320.08058 Specialty license plates.--

45 (23) KEEP KIDS DRUG-FREE LICENSE PLATES.--

46 (a) The department shall develop a Keep Kids Drug-Free
 47 license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida"
 48 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Keep Kids
 49 Drug-Free" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

50 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Keep
 51 Kids Drug-Free Foundation, Inc., which shall use the fees to
 52 fund activities to reduce substance abuse among residents of

53 | this state. The foundation shall develop a plan to distribute
 54 | the funds for drug-abuse prevention programs.

55 | (c) Notwithstanding s. 320.08062, up to 10 percent of the
 56 | proceeds from the annual use fee may be used for marketing the
 57 | Keep Kids Drug-Free license plate and for administrative costs
 58 | directly related to the management and distribution of the
 59 | proceeds.

60 | (26) FLORIDA MEMORIAL UNIVERSITY ~~COLLEGE~~ LICENSE PLATES.--

61 | (a) The department shall develop a Florida Memorial
 62 | University ~~College~~ license plate as provided in this section.
 63 | The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
 64 | words "Florida Memorial University ~~College~~" must appear at the
 65 | bottom of the plate.

66 | (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to Florida
 67 | Memorial University ~~College~~.

68 | (48) SPORTSMEN'S NATIONAL LAND TRUST LICENSE PLATES.--

69 | (a) The department shall develop a Sportsmen's National
 70 | Land Trust license plate as provided in this section. The word
 71 | "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words
 72 | "Sportsmen's National Land Trust" must appear at the bottom of
 73 | the plate.

74 | (b) The annual revenues from the sales of the license
 75 | plate shall be distributed to the Sportsmen's National Land
 76 | Trust. Such annual revenues must be used by the trust in the
 77 | following manner:

78 1. Fifty percent may be retained until ~~fifty percent of~~
 79 all startup costs for developing and establishing the plate have
 80 been recovered.

81 2. Twenty-five percent must be used to fund programs and
 82 projects within the state that preserve open space and wildlife
 83 habitat, promote conservation, improve wildlife habitat, and
 84 establish open space for the perpetual use of the public.

85 3. Twenty-five percent may be used for promotion,
 86 marketing, and administrative costs directly associated with
 87 operation of the trust.

88 (c) When the provisions of subparagraph (b)1. are met,
 89 those annual revenues shall be used for the purposes of
 90 subparagraph (b)2.

91 (57) HOMEOWNERSHIP FOR ALL LICENSE PLATES.--

92 (a) The department shall develop a Homeownership For All
 93 license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida"
 94 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Support
 95 Homeownership For All" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

96 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to
 97 Homeownership For All, Inc., which may use a maximum of 10
 98 percent of the proceeds to promote and market the plate. The
 99 remainder of the proceeds shall be used by Homeownership For
 100 All, Inc., to fund programs that provide, promote, or otherwise
 101 support affordable housing in this state.

102 Section 3. Subsection (5) of section 320.0807, Florida
 103 Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (6), and a new subsection
 104 (5) is added to that section to read:

105 | 320.0807 Special license plates for Governor and federal
106 | and state legislators.--

107 | (5) Upon application by any current or former President of
108 | the Senate and payment of the fees prescribed by s. 320.0805,
109 | the department is authorized to issue a license plate stamped in
110 | bold letters "Senate President" followed by the number assigned
111 | by the department or chosen by the applicant if it is not
112 | already in use. Upon application by any current or former
113 | Speaker of the House of Representatives and payment of the fees
114 | prescribed by s. 320.0805, the department is authorized to issue
115 | a license plate stamped in bold letters "House Speaker" followed
116 | by the number assigned by the department or chosen by the
117 | applicant if it is not already in use.

118 | Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
