**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 3, between lines 15 and 16,

insert:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 316.068, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.068 Crash report forms.--

(2) Every crash report required to be made in writing must be made on the appropriate form approved by the department and must contain all the information required therein, including the date, time, and location of the crash; a description of the vehicles involved; the names and addresses of the parties involved; the names and addresses of all drivers and passengers in the vehicles involved; the names and addresses of witnesses; the name, badge number, and law enforcement agency of the officer investigating the crash; and the names of the insurance companies for the respective parties involved in the crash, unless not available. 1 absence of information in such written crash reports regarding  
 2 the existence of passengers in the vehicles involved in the  
 3 crash constitutes a rebuttable presumption that no such  
 4 passengers were involved in the reported crash.

5 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, a crash  
 6 report produced electronically by a law enforcement officer  
 7 must, at a minimum, contain the same information as is called  
 8 for on those forms approved by the department.
