Section 3. Creation; purpose.--

(1) The Gainesville-Alachua County Regional Airport 52 Authority is created, and the powers granted by this act are 53 54 declared to be public and governmental functions, exercised for public purposes, and are matters of public necessity. Lands and 55 other real and personal property, easements, and privileges 56 57 acquired and used by the authority are declared to have been acquired for and used for public and governmental purposes and 58 as a matter of public necessity. The authority is a public body 59 corporate and is an independent special district. 60

(2) The authority shall have jurisdiction over the 61 operation and maintenance of, and improvements to, the airport 62 and airport facilities. The authority has jurisdiction, control, 63 supervision, and management over other airports in the county 64 except any airport owned, controlled, and operated by a private 65 person. Said jurisdiction, control, supervision, and management 66 are in the best interest of the county and each municipality. 67 Section 4. Membership of the authority .--68

The powers of the authority shall be vested in its 69 (1) members in office from time to time. There shall be nine 70 members. No member shall receive any compensation for services 71 as a member. As a condition of eligibility for appointment and 72 to hold office, each member shall reside within the city or the 73 county. However, one member appointed by the Governor may reside 74 75 in a county contiguous to Alachua County. No person shall serve 528647

78	(2) Upon expiration of initial terms of office, subsequent
79	appointments shall be made as follows:
80	(a) The Governor shall replace by appointment any of the
81	three members appointed by him or her under chapter 95-457, Laws
82	of Florida, on or prior to the date of expiration of the
83	preceding term.
84	(b) The board of county commissioners shall replace by
85	appointment the member appointed by it under chapter 95-457,
86	Laws of Florida, on or prior to the date of expiration of the
87	preceding term.
88	(c) The city commission shall replace by appointment any
89	of the remaining five members on or prior to the expiration of
90	the preceding term.
91	(3) If, upon expiration of a member's term of office, the
92	appointing entity fails to replace by appointment its member,
93	and the member is willing to continue to serve, the member with
94	the expired term shall continue to serve until a replacement
95	appointment is made.
96	(4) The term of any member initially appointed prior to
97	the effective date of this act shall expire on July 31 of the
98	year such member's term was scheduled to expire under chapter
99	95-457, Laws of Florida. No member shall serve more than two
100	successive terms.
101	(5) All members appointed subsequent to the effective date
102	of this act shall serve 3-year terms of office, beginning on
103	August 1 and expiring on July 31 of the appropriate year.

A vacant position shall remain vacant until a successor has been appointed by the appropriate appointing 108 109 entity. (7) A member may be removed by the entity appointing such 110 111 member upon grounds constituting misfeasance, neglect of duty, incompetence, or permanent inability to perform official duties. 112 Upon conviction of a felony, a member shall be automatically 113 removed. The unexcused failure to attend three consecutive 114 regular meetings of the authority shall be deemed neglect of 115 duty, without limiting the meaning of the term "neglect of 116 duty." 117 Section 5. Organization; meetings; notice; quorum.--A 118 chair, vice chair, and secretary-treasurer shall be chosen by 119 and from the authority membership. The chair, vice chair, and 120 secretary-treasurer shall each serve a term of office of 1 year, 121 and no member shall hold the same office for more than two 122 123 consecutive terms. The authority shall meet at the call of the chair, at 124 (1) the request of three or more of its members, and at such other 125 126 times as may be prescribed by rule of the authority. 127 The authority shall give notice of all meetings at (2) least 48 hours prior thereto, which shall be published in a 128 newspaper in general circulation in Alachua County, and shall 129 130 include agenda items whenever such items involve leasing of any airport property. Amendment No. (for drafter's use only) when there is an immediate danger to the public health, safety, 133 or welfare, do not require at least 48 hours' prior public 134 notice, and reasonable notice under the circumstances shall be 135 136 provided in such cases. 137 The presence of five members is required to constitute (3) a quorum, and the affirmative vote of a majority of the members 138 present and eligible to vote, but no fewer than four of the 139 140 members present and eligible to vote, is required for any action 141 or recommendation by the authority. Section 6. Restrictions. --142 143 (1) No person who has transacted business with the authority shall be eligible for appointment to the authority 144 until 3 years after the last transaction. No person who has 145 served on the authority shall be eligible to transact business 146 with the authority until 3 years after the person's last date of 147 service. Said transactions include transactions either for 148 oneself or as an employee of, agent for, or consultant to any 149 150 other person or legal entity. The provisions of 163 this subsection shall be cumulative to any general laws of the 164 state that may from time to time be applicable to members, 165 officers, agents, or employees of the authority and that require 166 the disclosure of, or prohibit, conflicts of interest. 167 (3) No member, as an individual, may represent the 168 169 authority, speak for the authority, or speak on behalf of the authority without being directed through a formal action of the 170 171 authority to do so. 172 Section 7. Powers and duties.--(1) The authority shall have jurisdiction over the 173 operation and maintenance of all airport and airport facilities 174in the city or county, except any airport owned and operated by 175 176 a private person. (2) The authority has the power to and may: 177 (a) Approve, file with the chief executive officer (CEO), 178 179 and pay any surety bond required of any member or of any employee of the authority. 180 (b) Advertise for sealed bids when required by law; 181 however, the authority may reject all bids and readvertise or 182 select a single item from any bid as further provided in this 183 184 act. 197	or agency of the state to provide law enforcement services and
198	protection through its duly sworn officers, and all such
199	officers shall have full power of arrest to prevent or abate the
200	commission of an offense against the ordinances of the city or
201	county, the laws of this state, or the laws of the United
202	States, when any such offense or threatened offense occurs upon
